Application and Award Guidelines

Any family with a student in the 4th through 8th grade may apply.

<u>4th-5th grade students:</u> grants are awarded based solely upon financial need, which is considered to be demonstrated if a family:

- already receives tuition assistance from the school,
- has more than one child enrolled in the school; or,
- has recently experienced a negative and/or unexpencted financial event.

6th-8th grade students: In addition to meeting the above financial criteria, these students must also demonstrate a commitment to their instrument along with consistent practice habits. These applications are reviewed by the private lessons instructor, orchestra teacher and class teacher.

Families may apply for a grant at any time; however, due to the limitations on overall funding, application in the beginning of the school year is strongly encouraged.

The range of grants awarded is between 25% and 50% of the cost of private lessons offered at the school (currently \$25 per half hour). The award, however, may be used to finance lessons arranged with any teacher chosen by the family.

Parents are notified in writing whether or not a grant has been awarded, including the total grant amount and how much will be paid for each lesson. Grants must be reapplied for annually, and in any year are not guaranteed to meet demonstrated need.

Music at the Waldorf School of Garden City

Music has always been an integral part of the curriculum at the Waldorf School of Garden City. From the earliest grades, children sing and play the recorder. Beginning in the 3rd or 4th grade, students choose an orchestral instrument, begin private music instruction, and perform as part of their class orchestra. This ongoing musical experience continues through the high school, where students sing regularly as a group and have opportunities to participate in select choral and orchestral ensembles. Music permeates every aspect of the school culture, and students develop a respect and appreciation for all forms of musical expression which lasts a lifetime.
