**Terms of Enrollment Agreement:**

Summer at the Waldorf School admits children of any race, color and ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, programs and activities. Tuition includes use of all facilities, tee shirt, snack and the cost of some day trips where applicable. The deposit is refundable until April 30, 2019 minus a \$50 processing fee. A non-refundable payment is due in full by June 9, 2019. There are no refunds for absences or withdrawals after camp has started. In the case of an extended illness that has resulted in five or more consecutive absences, a camper may be withdrawn for medical reasons documented by the camper's physician; in such cases, there will be a refund issued on tuition in excess of the non-refundable \$500 deposit, prorated based on attendance. For part time campers, every effort will be made to accommodate absences through schedule changes. For the general welfare of all campers, Summer at the Waldorf School reserves the unrestricted right to dismiss any camper whose conduct or influence, in the opinion of the Director, is detrimental to the best interests of the camp. Admission is limited due to the needs of the program. Summer at The Waldorf School tennis and swimming programs take place at Adelphi University. Summer at the Waldorf School will not be responsible for any lost or stolen items. In the event that this agreement is executed by one parent, the signer acknowledges that he/she is also acting as the agent of the other parent with authority to enroll his/her child at Camp and to execute this agreement on his or her behalf. By signing on the registration form, I acknowledge that I have read and understand the terms and accept the conditions. Photographs, names or other media images, recordings or materials of the undersigned and/or the camper covered by this agreement may be used by the camp at any time in the future for brochures, videos, websites, prints or other publicity or marketing purposes. Upon registration, please inform Summer at The Waldorf School if your child has any special needs.



Offering both half and full day programs, flexible scheduling, a variety of quality activities and special events led by dedicated and talented counselors — our program creates an atmosphere of lively, yet relaxed, summer fun!

## EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAM

**Nursery - Kindergarten Ages 3 - 5**  
**Choose Half-Day 8:30-12:00pm or Full Day 8:30-3:00pm.**

The program offers a rich play experience for the youngest campers. Activities include outdoor free play in our preschool yards, watercolor painting, seasonal crafts, singing, cooking, yoga, story-telling, rhymes, verses and puppetry. Juice and a healthy mid-morning snack are provided. Four & five year old campers also participate in our swimming program.



## FIRST - EIGHTH GRADE PROGRAM

**Entering grades 1 - 8 in fall 2019**  
**Full Day - 8:30am - 3:00pm**

The program includes a wide variety of activities designed to engage the interest and enthusiasm of children from lower school to teen. In addition to activities led by their counselors, campers participate in tennis (2nd-8th grades), arts & crafts, painting, yoga, music, sports & games, cooking, gardening, drama, swimming, and outdoor water play. Special events include; Tie-Dye Week, Field Day and "Summertime Stars" talent show. Campers bring lunch from home each day, and the camp provides a mid-morning snack.

## SWIMMING PROGRAM



Campers age 4 and older once again have regular swimming at the newly renovated Adelphi University pool facilities. The swimming program includes a structured "Learn to Swim" Program focused on fun and water safety.

## WEEKLY EXCURSIONS

**4th - 8th grade**

Our oldest campers enjoy the variety of weekly field trips to local points of interest, such as canoeing on the Nissequogue River, cheering at a *New York Mets* baseball game, or making waves at *Splish Splash* water amusement park. Transportation

for these trips is by chartered, air-conditioned bus, and parents are notified in advance of fees and required permissions slips for each excursion.



## FLEXIBLE ENROLLMENT & AFTERCARE

An important feature of our program is the flexible scheduling option. While we encourage all our campers to take advantage of the full program, we recognize that family vacations and other activities may conflict with camp. Parents can create a part-time schedule that suits their family needs with tuition on a pro-rated basis (see accompanying fee schedule). Please note that a minimum of 24 days of enrollment is required for every camper. Child care is available before camp, and after the camp day ends until 6 pm, for \$9 per hour.

## TRANSPORTATION

Parents are required to provide transportation for their children to and from camp each day.

## SIBLING DISCOUNT

With events and activities suited to a wide range of ages, families often enroll more than one child in our program. Each additional sibling receives a tuition discount as follows: 20% for the second child, 30% for the 3rd, and 40% for the fourth.

## CIT PROGRAM

Summer at the Waldorf School offers a 3-week CIT program for 14 – 16 year olds who are interested in becoming camp counselors or exploring personal growth and leadership experiences. Designed to help young people develop their personal awareness along with the basic skills of camp leadership, the Program is led by an experienced CIT Advisor, with support



from the Camp Director and other key camp staff. For more information and an application, visit our website or call the summer program office listed below.
