



Dear Nursery Parents,

I hope this letter finds you and your children enjoying the warm, relaxing days of summer while enjoying the wonders of this glorious season. As August fades, we happily look ahead to the new school year. I am so happy to welcome both our returning families as well as our new families to our class. I realize that all of you have navigated through uncharted waters during the past six months and I am eager to support you and your child throughout the year ahead. For some of you this will be the very first days of your child's long journey through school. It is certainly a joyful milestone, and I am looking forward to beginning this experience with you and your children.

Our program will look a little different this year as we navigate through new protocols. Happily we will be spending much more time outside. I look forward to the many healing benefits this outdoor time will provide.

Many families like to plan ahead, and I thought you might appreciate my sharing with you a list of supplies your child will need for school.

Supplies for your child's cubby:

1. Approximately 3 changes of clothing (including underwear, socks, pants/shorts and shirts.) Since much of our time will be spent outdoors, multiple changes of clothing will be needed to keep your child comfortable and dry on rainy days. We will ask you to update these articles of clothing throughout the year.

2. Sweater, sweatshirt or light jacket.

3. Sunhat or cap with face shield. Here are some helpful links.

4. Soft inside shoes or slippers (must completely cover the foot and heel). A canvas sneaker or full slipper works best.
5. Small resting pillow
6. Two sets of rain gear: Raincoat with hood, rain pants and rain boots. Brands such as Abeko, Lands End, Reima Tihku, Oaki and Tuffo are all popular brands and can be purchased on Amazon.
7. Yoga mat and child's sleeping bag for short outdoor resttime.

All supplies should be clearly labeled with your child's name (please remember this when new items are brought to school).

Important Dates

Our first parent meeting will be held, in person, on our nursery playground - *Monday, August 31st at 5:30pm*. We will discuss what to expect during the first days of school as well as preview the year ahead. Please bring any questions you have, including any new protocols that we have in place for this school year. Your questions will help contribute to a lively, healthy conversation. This evening will also be a great opportunity to meet one another!

Our first day of school is *Wednesday, September 9th*. During the first two days of school, *Wednesday, September 9th and Thursday, September 10th*, the children will come to school for only one hour, from 9:00-10:00. On *Friday, September 11th* the children will come together for a two-hour day, from 9:00-11:00. On *Monday, September 14th* we will begin the regular school schedule, 9:00-12:00, including Early Dropoff and Afternoon Care. I know this may sound a bit complicated but it helps the children to make a smooth transition into school. In past years, this gradual introduction has been very helpful to the children. If you have any special requests or needs, please feel free to contact me or speak to me at the parent evening.

During the school year I am available to discuss any questions or concerns you may have. We will plan for five parent meetings throughout the year as well as personal meeting times, as needed.

I will be working in our playyard and happily welcome visitors. Here are the available time slots :
