- The **Essay must include a work cited page** or a **bibliography** if your writing requires research, however, a works cited page is not required if you do not need to do research to complete your writing.
- All **quotes** for the art submission must **include the name of the person** who said it. (Example, “when they go low, we go high” - Michelle Obama), however you do not need to have a citation or bibliography for the quote.
- Please **take a picture(s) of your artwork** for your submission. A physical copy is not required for the contest; however, we would like to display the artwork in the school hallways in the following weeks so you may bring it in then.
