NYSSMA 2022

Application Form

The New York State School Music Association (“NYSSMA”) Festival is adjudication for the advancement of solo and ensemble skills. This year the evaluation process will be done **IN PERSON at MINEOLA HIGH SCHOOL MAY 20-21***

(*April 12-13 in Plainview for Classical Guitar)

Your child should consult with their private music teacher regarding the music selection and completion of this form. Music must be chosen from the NYSSMA Manual XXXII, dated July 2018.

Submit the completed form to Ms. Schooley with a **check made payable to The Waldorf School of Garden City**. No cash is allowed.

You will find the amount due below, depending on the level your child is performing.

The Process:

- Students will be recommended to perform a solo from their private music teacher
- The selected piece of music must be purchased by the student/parent (and must be listed in the NYSSMA Manual). All students must have (2) original copies of their solo: one for them to use and one for the adjudicator. If they are performing by memory, they only need one copy for the adjudicator. Please note - Photocopies of music are NOT permitted at NYSSMA Festivals.
- The student will be registered by their school after receiving the completed registration form and payment is confirmed
- The student will receive a “playing permit” about a week before the festival date giving them the specific day, time and room that they will be performing in. They must bring this permit to the audition.

Deadlines:

- Classical Guitar NYSSMA applications and payments are due no later than Tuesday, February 11th, 2022.
- **All other applications and payments are due no later than Friday, March 4th, 2022**

Accompaniment:

Some solos, like vocal solos, require accompaniment. Recorded accompaniments are most commonly used for vocal solos and students must bring in their own playback device to their audition.

Since not all vocal rooms have a piano available, the NYSSMA host needs to know what kind of room to assign you for your performance. Please note your requirements on the application form.

All-State students: Piano accompanists are only required for certain All-State solos. Please consult your private music teacher to find out if you need one.
