#### **DEPOSIT REQUIREMENT**

A non-refundable enrollment deposit of 5% of tuition is required with a returned contract for all current students. A non-refundable enrollment deposit of 20% is required for all new students. This payment and the signed contract must be returned by February 15, 2024, for re-enrollment or no later than 14 days after issuance of a new contract. The deposit will be credited toward tuition.

Space in the School cannot be guaranteed for any student should the School not receive the signed contract and enrollment deposit by the due date.

## **BUSINESS AFFAIRS**

#### **ACTIVITY FEES**

Annual student activity fees are payable with the first tuition payment. These fees cover most class activities, class trips to Camp Glen Brook, class field trips, school issued supplies, The Waldorf School News, one school yearbook per family (additional copies may be ordered in the high school), festivals, many school events, and class dues of \$50 per student.

### **ANNUAL GIVING**

The Waldorf School of Garden City celebrates a strong tradition of Annual Giving. Our School relies on the Annual Fund to bridge the gap between tuition income and the actual cost of running the School. Parents, faculty, staff, alumni, alumni parents, trustees, and friends work together toward a goal of 100% participation each year. Contributions to Annual Giving help to reduce tuition rate increases. Unlike tuition, donations to the Annual Fund are tax-deductible. We thank all the parents for their participation.

#### **PAYMENT PLANS**

Parents choose their method of payment annually when student contracts are issued. Please note, the School imposes a late fee of 1.5% per month on overdue balances. Enrollment in Blackbaud Tuition Management program is required. Information about Blackbaud Tuition Management can be found in your parent portal and is also available in the Business Office.

### **OPTION 1: Payment in full, save 2%**

- Enrollment Deposit on return of signed contract
- 100% tuition paid on or before June 30th (less the Enrollment Deposit) to receive a 2% discount on total tuition

## **OPTION 2: Two (2) Payment Plan**

- Enrollment Deposit on return of signed contract
- 50% of the tuition (less Enrollment Deposit) due by July 5<sup>th</sup>
- 50% tuition due by December 5<sup>th</sup>

#### **OPTION 3: Four (4) Payment Plan**

- Enrollment Deposit on return of signed contract
- 25% of the tuition (less Enrollment Deposit) on or before July 5<sup>th</sup>, October 5<sup>th</sup>, January 5<sup>th</sup>, and April 5<sup>th</sup>

## **OPTION 4: Ten (10) Payment Plan**

- Enrollment Deposit on return of signed contract.
- A ten-month schedule of payments running from July to April.

Please note: Tuition payments received after their due dates will incur a \$50 late fee.
